The following information is from Club member Joe Boone who spoke after our February meeting:

Bill SB0023/HB0702 pertains to Tennessee HandGun Carry Permit holders (HCP) to legally be armed while in restaurants that serve alcohol. The the bill passed the Senate and is now in the House of Representatives.

Rep. Debra Maggart stated that she believes HB0702 will pass in the House of Representatives if Rep. Curry Todd can receive assistance in getting it out of the subcommittee. Debra suggest we all email the subcommittee members to lobby for their votes. Additional email to other Representatives will also help if HB0702 does get out of the subcommittee!

The bill is currently in the Criminal Practice and Procedure Subcommittee which is part of the Judiciary Committee. Rep. Janis Sontany is Chair of the sub-committee and members are: Rep. Henry Fincher - Rep. Eddie Bass - Rep. Rob Briley - Rep. Judd Matheny - and Rep. Eric Watson. These are all key members to be contacted.
