Information from the TVA:

No Member is to ask a TVA employee to open the gate to the club. TVA employees do not have that authority. No Member is to contact the TVA offices. If you have a problem at the club, contact on of the Club officers and per our by-laws, communication will be done through the proper channels. We must remember TVA is in the business of making electricity, not maintaining our gun club.

TVA property is a wildlife-protected area (TWRA). Penalties are severe for shooting any wildlife. Everyone must scan their gate card to enter the gate legally. If 2 are in a car, both scan their card. No metal targets/plates closer than the 50 yds. Bianchi Plates no closer than 25 yds. The metal animal targets are for cast bullets only. Wood benches are for gear only, not bench rest. TVA range across the street is off limits
